a vibrant, inclusive, and engaging campus atmosphere, emphasizing both academic and cultural growth.

Center for Excellence:

Research Center:

- A total of **10 research scholars** have been admitted to the **Ph.D. program in Commerce**, with **2 scholars** specifically joining under the **guidance of esteemed research supervisors Dr. N. Santhana Vadivu and Dr. R. Bhuvaneswaran**.

IPR Cell:

- The PG Department of Computer Science organized an IPR workshop on "**Patent File & Grant**," while the B.Com Accounting & Finance department hosted a seminar on "**Protection of IPR**," both with expert resource persons.

e-Governance:

- **Embase ERP** is being utilized at TNC for the collection and management of academic, administrative, scholarship, and welfare data, including **Puthumai Penn, Tamil Puthalvan, and SC/ST scholarships**.

IQAC:

- IQAC hosted the **Yuvamanthon MUN**, focused on the theme "**Lifestyle for Environment**," featuring **AIPPM (National level) and COP 29 (International level) committees**. Students engaged as delegates and were awarded **UGC certificates** for their participation.
- TNC-IQAC organized a transformative **3-day PDP on AI Tools for Teaching, enhancing the skills of 117 staff members**. A Faculty Development Programme focused on **leadership and collaboration, benefiting 30 participants**, while a **Financial Education workshop strengthened the capabilities of 32 non-teaching staff**. Additionally, a **Mentoring Workshop** nurtured faculty leadership potential, reinforcing quality across the institution.

- TNC has achieved significant recognition, including **NAAC Re-Accreditation with a B++ Grade** and successful **ISO Audit Certification for 2024-2025**. TNC Softskill Hub:

- TNC Soft Skill Hub, in **collaboration with Naandi Foundation**, conducted **training for 30 hrs, benefiting 719 students**.
- The **Placement Cell & Soft Skill Hub**, in **partnership with Magic Bus &Anudip Foundation**, organized **training for 30 hrs, benefiting 379 individuals**.

UNOM-Institute of Distance Education:

- "Offering a comprehensive range of **UG, PG, MBA, and MCA programs for the academic year 2024-2025**, TNC has successfully admitted **167 students in 2023-2024** and **221 students in 2024-2025**, totaling **388 new enrollments**."

Placement Cell:

- **03 mega job drives** were successfully conducted, resulting in **45 companies** visiting the campus. These drives led to a total offer value of **6.19 Lakh CTC**, with the highest package for the year. Among the **825 final year students**, **681 received offer letters**, and the average offer per student stood at **2.5 Lakh CTC**.

TNC Media Centre:

- TNC Media Centre actively engages with its audience through various platforms including **Instagram, Facebook, YouTube, Twitter, and WhatsApp**. These channels are used to share updates, promote events, interact with students and alumni, and provide real-time communication, ensuring seamless connectivity and enhanced community engagement.

Master Minds(SDC):

- The **Student Development Council (Master Minds)** elected office bearers at TNC play a key role in nurturing **leadership skills**. They actively engage students in various initiatives, fostering growth in **teamwork, responsibility, and decision-making**. This empowers students to develop the qualities necessary for future leadership roles.

Incubation Cell:

- Thiruthangal Nadar College's Incubation Cell hosted **INNOVATION EXPO-2024**, showcasing 17 teams with creative solutions, followed by a second-level event with 21 student projects. Additionally, **NEXTGEN NEXUS-25** saw 27 teams, with Patrician College and Loyola College winning the Hackathon, and MOP Vaishnav and Karpaga Vinayaka College excelling in Business Plan Presentation.

Entrepreneurship Cell:

- The **Entrepreneurship Club** organized a session on opportunities in palm and herbal handmade products, engaging 450 students. The **ED Cell** facilitated workshops on entrepreneurial growth and conducted a skill development program focused on bakery products, benefiting 30 participants. Additionally, a **tailoring class** was held, along with a stall showcasing student-made creations, further promoting hands-on skills and entrepreneurship.

- T.Kishore, a **BCA** student and an active **NSS Volunteer**, participated in the **State-Level National Youth Festival**.
- Thiruthangal Nadar College's NCC unit **won 1st and 3rd prizes at the Thyagabhoosanam Fest, competing against 16+ colleges**.
- The NSS & NCC organized several impactful initiatives, including a **free eye check-up and medical camp** with **D.K. Eye Care**, benefiting the local community. The **Mega Blood Donation Camp** saw **339 units donated**, while **45 students participated in breast cancer screening**. Awareness programs on **cybercrime, online safety, suicide prevention and Solid Waste Management** engaged **600 participants**.
- The NCC unit hosted a **Rank Promotion Ceremony** with Senior JCO Satpal and NCO Murugesan from 1 (TN) ARMD SQN NCC in attendance.

Community Empowerment Initiatives under UBA:

- Thiruthangal Nadar College adopted **five villages** under the **Unnat Bharat Abhiyan**, organizing impactful outreach programs. These included **tree plantation drives, free medical camps, awareness campaigns on organic farming, career guidance, health programs, and street theatre on the harmful effects of alcohol and drugs**.

Queen-Women Safety & Welfare Club:

- A session was held for **500 girls**, focusing on **safety measures, social media risks, and promoting the Kaavalan Uthavi app**. A **Skill Development Programme** for **400 students** covered **interview preparation**, while specialists conducted an **awareness session on protecting against breast and cervical cancer**.

ECO Club:

- The **Green Environment & Eco Club** organized a **cycle rally, a nature conservation workshop**, and promoted the use of **Manja pie bags**, actively encouraging sustainable practices and environmental awareness.

Library:

- As of 2024, the library holds a total of **17,098+ books**, with **921 new books** purchased this year, totaling **Rs. 4,47,408**. An additional **124 books** were contributed by alumni. The library also recorded a **2,294+ online footfall** and **16,864+ offline footfall**. A **3-day book exhibition and donation program** was organized, resulting in **55 books donated by students** and **114 books donated by faculty members**.

Student Scholarship and Staff Welfare:

- The management took great pride in granting merit scholarships amounting to **Rs 26, 55,900 to 511 students**, alongside sports scholarships totaling **Rs 1, 31,625 for 16 deserving athletes**.
- As a gesture of staff welfare, the management granted an additional **Rs 4,32,000** in course remuneration to **36 staff members** for their contribution to overseeing **30 add-on courses**.
- The management contributed a total of **Rs. 1,33,000** for **Teachers' Day**, with **Rs. 1,000** allocated for each staff member as a token of appreciation.
- The management generously awarded a financial contribution of **Rs 10,200** to **10 staff members** who successfully completed **NPTEL courses**, recognizing their dedication to professional development and lifelong learning.

Alumni Association:

- Alumni scholarships amounting to **Rs. 1,92,350** were granted to **39 students**.
- **06 Alumni Guest Lectures** are delivered on the campus as a knowledge contribution programme.

PTA Meeting:

The **PTA meeting**, conducted **twice a year**, offers parents an opportunity to engage with the institution, review **students' progress**, and ensure **transparency**, with parents playing an active role as key stakeholders in the educational process.

TNC Success Story:

- Our success story reflects significant milestones: **1,016 admissions, 33 MoUs, 105 NPTEL certifications, 180 ICT courses, and 1,711 addon courses.** We have supported **612 students through scholarships**, celebrated the achievements of **805 graduates at the convocation**, and facilitated **681 placements**, showcasing our commitment to academic excellence and student success.
