VISIT TO JUVENILE HOME

Dated on 05/12/2022

We were introduced to the children of the Juvenile home; they were all gathered in a single room and the officials allowed us to interact with the children. We had interacted with many juvenile delinquencies of different classes of offences they are booked under. There were delinquencies who were involved in petty offences such as theft, robbery as well as serious offences such as murder and rape. Many of the delinquencies were introduced to criminality due to peer group pressure & influence, lack of social and parental care. There was no segregation of class of offenders as like in correctional facilities which would make it easier for the first time offenders to get involved with hardened delinquents to involve in more criminal acts further.

The Police station visit which was allowed at the D-1 Police Station ,Triplicane was really useful for the Students of second year,Thiruthangal Nadar College.Totally 21 students along with the 2 staffs has participated in the Police station visit and the Assistant Commissioner Dr.Baskar ,Inspector Mohan Raj,Sub-Inspector Kumar ,Head kumaraveletc..has taken sessions and explained about various duties and responsibilities of police. inspector kumar has explained about the crime scene procedures, various registers maintained, duty experiences with examples and Head Constable Kumaravelu also explained in detail about the duties regarding the administration of Police force and firearms were also shown for the students .The students have taken an oath aganist the usage of drugs. Also, the demos of pistols and various other guns wereshown to the students including their working. It was a great exposureto the students as the police station management and their administration is a part of their Curriculum.

Purpose of visit:

To learn about the objective, role and functions of State Human Right Commission

Description:

The first session was conducted by Mr. Sugumaran from law department, he explained about administration, law and investigation aspects of SHRC. The second session was followed by a Judicial Magistrate Mam, she briefly explained about the judicial proceedings of the Human right cases filed through SHRC. The third session conducted by Mr. Kumar, Deputy Superintendent of Police, he explained about case investigation part in aspects of custodial death, custodial torture, natural and accidental death. What are the human rights violation in such cases are explained very clearly by Mr. Kumar sir. The next session was taken by Inspector of Police; she covers the area of Crime scene procedure, importance of evidences, collection and examination of the evidences which helps in the conviction of the offender.

Our students had learnt about the role, duties, functions of SHRC along with the morality, equality, definition of violence and the essential rights that a person can enjoy in India as a Indian Citizen.
