
INDUSTRIAL VISIT (26-09-2022)

It is a necessary academic activity to send our students for an industrial visit; in accordance, twenty-two (22) final-year students from the department of Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Plant Biology & Plant Biotechnology visited the CSIR–Madras complex, Taramani, on 26.09.2022 at 8.30 A.M. by college van. It was the occasion of the CSIR foundation day celebration, Open Day; students from various colleges were permitted on the campus. The students were able to witness various activities carried out by the satellite laboratories accommodated in the complex, like the National Environmental Engineering and Research Institute (NEERI), Central Electrochemical Research Institute (CECRI), National Metallurgical Laboratory (NML), Central Scientific Instruments Organization (CSIO), and Central Electronics Engineering Institute (CEEI), in the form of working models. The faculty of basic sciences accompanied the students on the industrial visit. Students observed the demo of fuel cells, cracker making, the production of electric current from vegetables, etc., and they returned back to college by 3.00 P.M. Feedback on the industrial visit was collected from the students.
