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5 DAYS CERTIFICATE COURSE ON COUNSELING PSYCHOLOGY

Department of social work, Thiruthangal Nadar College in collaboration with FEMA, organized a 5 days certificate course on counseling psychology from 17th October to 21st October, 2022. Day 1session started with inaugural. Dr. Solomon raj, Director of Shelter Trust was the special guest. The Resource person Mr. Sridhar, Assistant professor, Department of Social work MSSW explained about psychology and history of psychology, normal and abnormal psychology. After noon was activity session on client and counselor practice conducted by Mr. Mohan, coordinator of FEMA. In the Day 2 Session was handled by Mr. Sridhar, Assistant professor, Department of Social work, MSSW. Theories of psychology, goals of psychology, and introduction to counseling were explained to students. After noon was activity session on client and counselor practice by Mr. Mohan, coordinator of FEMA. Day 3 session was handled by Resource person Ms. Lydia Nancy, Family Counselor. She explained about counseling, types of counseling, elements, process of counseling. In the afternoon session meditation and relaxation therapy was practiced. On the Day 4 Resource person Ms. Abirami, Counselling psychologist explained about child mental health, parental techniques and factors influencing child mental health. Afternoon session was handled by resource person Ms. Ananya Lakshmi, Assistant Professor Department of Psychology, MSSW who explained about Nonverbal communication among children and related activities. Day 5 resource person was Mr. Mohan, Coordinator of FEMA, discussed about mental health issues of adolescents and had an evaluation and feedback session. During valedictory, certificates were issued to the students. Totally 34 students and 5 staff members were benefited by this certificate course.







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AWARENESS ON CHIEF MINISTER COMPREHENSIVE HEALTH INSURANCE SCHEME AND DISTRIBUTION OF UPDATED CARDS

The students were made aware about First Aid and its importance, different type of first aid depending on the type of case. The students were also made to understand about Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the trainers gave a demonstration on the process of performing CPR. The students were also encouraged to perform CPR to the model. The participants were provided with a certificate. 25 students were benefitted by the training Program.
