

The list of people who didn't have printed health insurance card were taken so that they can be helped to get the card. The I BSW students rendered their services in the camp.

It was found that many of the community people did not get Rs.1000/- . Their current statuses were checked and the reasons were found as:

- KMUT application was rejected due to 2.5 lakhs annual income
- KMUT was rejected due to own use cars
- KMUT was rejected because they were in government jobs and receiving government pension
- KMUT was rejected due to incorrect phone numbers

Few among them said that the reason is incorrect, so appeal was made. 70 people got benefited from this camp on KMUT. I BSW students rendered their services.
