### SWAYAM-NPTEL CHAPTER

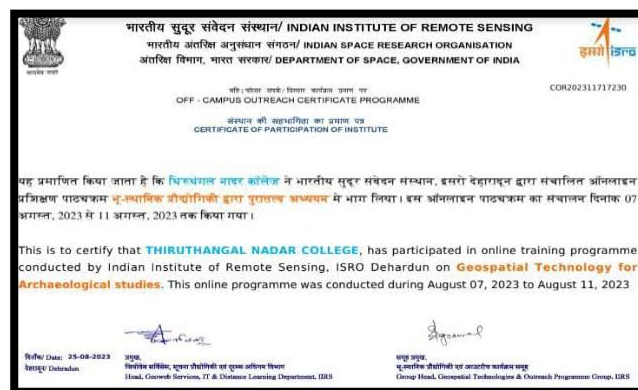
Another added feature in our curriculum is the adoption of **Swayam NPTEL Local Chapter MOOC integration**. This

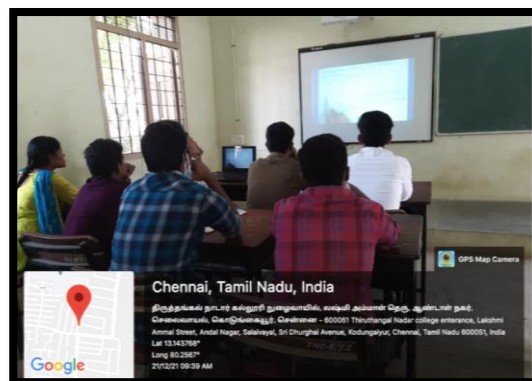
## INNOVATION IN TNC

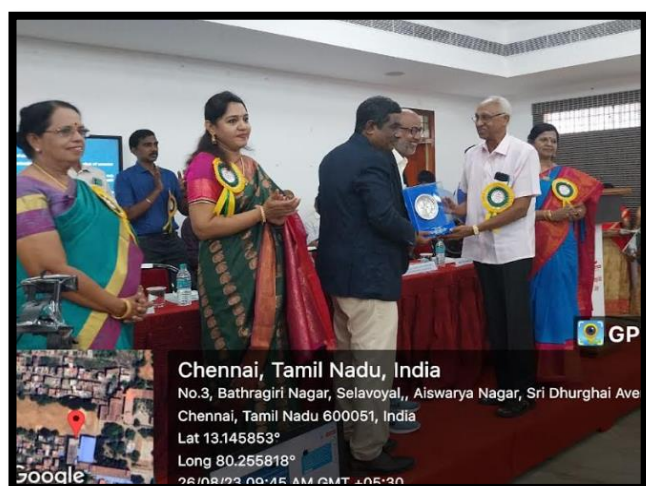

## B.SC COMPUTER SCIENCE

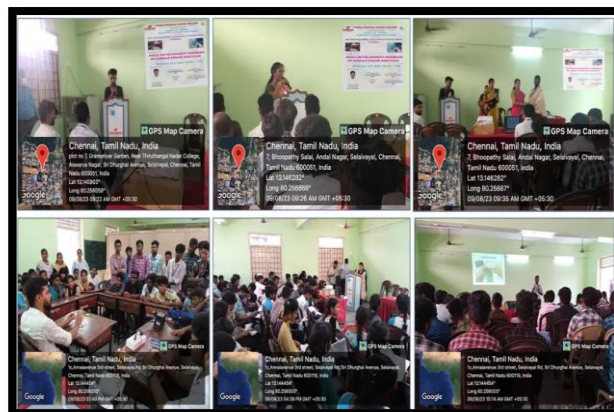

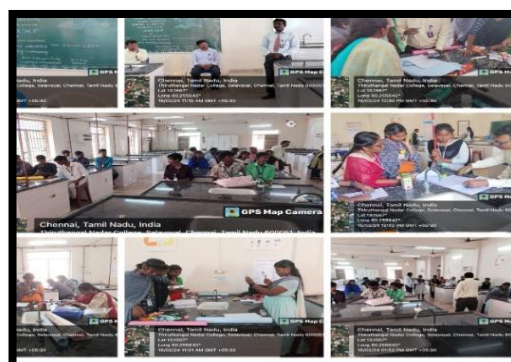

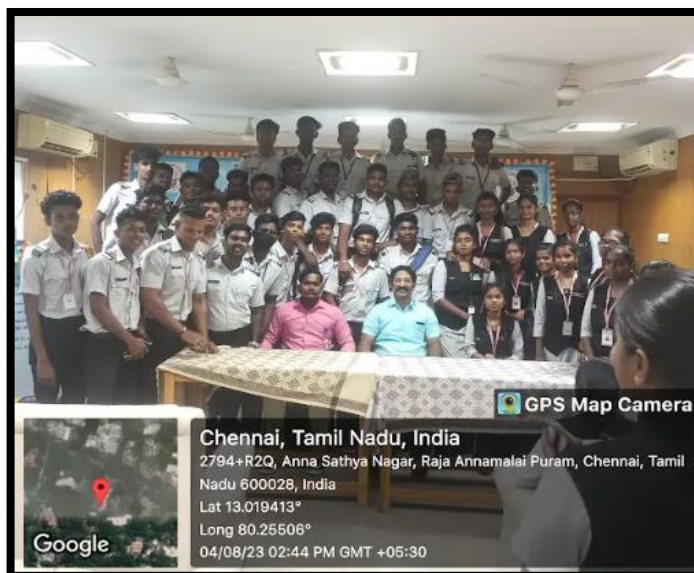
## GREEN ENVIRONMENT & ECO CLUB
