It gives me great pleasure to present unto you the Annual Report for the year 2019-2020.

Thiruthangal Nadar College was established in the year 1997 by Thiruthangal Nadar Educational Society, a wing of the Chennaivazh Thiruthangal Hindu Nadar Uravinmurai Dharma Fund. The hall marks of the Education we disseminate here are quality education, development of self-confidence, commitment to excellence and a holistic outlook on life along with decorum.

In a short span of 23 years the college has reached the zenith of its progress in many facets and has carved a niche for itself in North Chennai. Every year the college gains momentum in its ambience and reputation. The College now offers 17 U.G. Courses, one five-year integrated course M.Sc (CS&T) and two P.G. courses M.Sc (C.S) & M.Com. The current strength of the College in Shift-I is 3006 (1948 Boys & 1058 Girls) & Shift-II is 452 (309 Boys & 143 Girls) with 121Teaching Faculty in Shift-I and 15 Teaching faculty in Shift-II and 80 supporting staff. Owing to the growing demand of the new courses for the students the college has introduced two new courses namely B.A., (Tamil) & B.Sc. (Criminology) in this academic year.

This illustrious academic year 20119-20 turned out to be a year full of activities and exuberance.

The Teaching Faculty of the college are highly dynamic & efficient. Thirty five Faculty have obtained their doctorates in their respective disciplines and forty five of them have qualified themselves in National Eligibility Test & State Eligibility Test.

The extensive coaching rendered by our dynamic faculty members in line with the diligence and the dedication of our devoted students have resulted in many University Ranks in this academic year. I am glad to profess that the Dept. of Software Application has produced Five University Rank Holders in this Academic year. S.Muralikrishnan of B.Sc.(S.A) has secured the First Rank followed by P.Anand, K.Sankareswaran, M.Ranjith, M.Tamilarasan in 2^{nd} , 4^{th} , 5^{th} & 6^{th} Ranks respectively. R. Sakthi Kathiravan of B.Com. (C.A) has procured the 3^{rd} Rank and R.Shamini of B.Sc. (M) has secured the 10^{th} Rank. All the meritorious Rank Holders were honoured with gold coins on the College Graduation day.

Our college convened a meeting for the Freshers' along with their parents on 1st July 2019, which turned out to be rewarding session.

An orientation programme was designed for the students by the Department of English, Tamil, Computer Application, Computer Science and Software Application, Business Administration, Commerce and B.Com.(Computer Application) to support the new students as they begin a new academic journey.
